WEF has started working in Pakistan and Tajikistan and is in the process of assessing the need in these countries as well as identifying reliable partners to improve lives of children and youth in line with our vision. With the expansion of our work WEF increased its board members. Mr.Amirdin Masani, Mr.Jamal Premjee and Mr.Rafique Hassan joined our board and will be our champions in India, Pakistan and Tajikistan.

One of the projects that WEF has initiated simultaneously in all the three countries is the WEF- MBA Scholarship Program.

WEF-MBA Scholarship Program 2017

WEF-MBA Scholarship Program for 2017 is initiated with the objective of providing access to higher education for some of the brightest students we work with in India, Pakistan and Tajikistan

Through this program 10 qualified recipients will receive a full tuition scholarship from an Internationally Recognized University in the US to enroll in their MBA program as well as the WEF Residential Scholarship.



The Scholarship has been announced simultaneously in India, Pakistan and Tajikistan. This program will give students from these countries to study in the US and return to serve their communities and countries.

First Project in Tajikistan: Advanced English Language Course (Khorogh Tajikistan)

Worldwide Education Fund of the Dallas Foundation (WEF) launched its first project in Khorogh Tajikistan in collaboration with "Partner+Transfers". This project will prepare college students to improve their IELTS scores. 20 students have been selected through an assessment test and they meet 5 days a week for the class. IELTS (International English Language Testing System) is the world's most popular English language test. It opens doors to opportunity and people who take IELTS can study, work and live in any part of the world.



We are proud to announce that WEF is collaborating with University of Central Asia (UCA) for this project.

New Partnership: Heart House

WEF is also collaborating with Heart House, a Dallas based not for profit and works with marginalized and traumatized refugee children from various backgrounds and ethnicities. It provides them safety and education. Connie and Kamal Daya Gift Fund of The Dallas Foundation funded three staff of Heart House to attend The Refugee Trauma Recovery in Resettlement Conference that was held in Sydney Australia from 29th to 31st March.

The conference is dedicated to exploring the most innovative and successful ways to support refugees as they recover from trauma and resettle. The staff of Heart House will be able to bring back effective community development strategies and empower the Refugee Community through effective trauma interventions.

We hope to continue this partnership with the Heart House to help the Refugee kids from different countries.
